Memorial Baptist Summer Camp provides children entering Kindergarten—7th grade with amazing supervised activities that encourage friendship & fun! We are located right in the heart of Metairie, where the interstate meets Veterans Blvd. Camp activities include Games, Sports, Movies, a Trampoline area, on-site Swimming and local Field Trips.

Camp Dates June 5, 2023—August 4, 2023 (9 weeks)

Registration Fee: \$25 Per Child or \$40 per Family

Registration includes 1 camp shirt (Additional camp shirts may be purchased for \$10.00) Memorial Camp shirt must be worn on field trip days.

To register: Bring in complete registration form & payment in person to our school office. Your campers' 1st week of camp MUST be paid at the time of registration to reserve camp spot. (no exceptions)



<u>**Cost</u>** \$160 per week (includes Field trip costs)</u>

Camp Weeks selected at registration are considered your camper's reservation for that week and will be charged. A cancellation notice must be sent to our office by email one week in advance of reserved camp week.

<u>Camp Times</u> 8 a.m. — 4 p.m.

Before & After Care Before Care is offered from 7—8 a.m. and After Care is offered from 4 - 6 p.m. Cost is \$2 per hour (or \$1 per half hour) to be paid at the end of the camp week.

<u>Age Groups</u> 4/5 year olds entering Kindergarten—"Kiddie Camp," 6 & 7 Boys, 6 & 7 Girls, 8 & 9 Boys, 8 & 9 Girls, 10, 11 & 12 Boys & Girls *MBSC maintains a 18:1 staff to camper ratio.*

Pickup and Drop Off will be in the school cafeteria.

Camp Lunchtime & Snack

Students may bring their own lunch & snack to camp or they may purchase items at our camp's concession area. Lunch options include Pizza by the slice (\$2.50), Hot dogs (\$2), Lunchables (\$3), chips (\$1), juice & other snacks.

Swimming Program

MBSC has multiple above ground pools on-site (2 1/2 ft. and 4 ft.) Our pools are supervised by certified lifeguards at all times. The campers will be able to play games and enjoy fun in the pool according to their age. Campers can bring "floaties", puddle jumpers, goggles, etc. with them to swim – please be sure to label ALL items.

Dress Code

All campers must wear comfortable, athletic shoes, pants or shorts, shirts. Clothing apparel must be appropriate for camp activities. Campers have a chance to swim every day...weather cooperating! Please pack and label items appropriately (towel, sunscreen, etc.)

Kiddie Campers should also bring a comfortable, labeled napmat with them to camp. They will have quiet movie time in the afternoons.

Field Trips Camp t-shirts must be worn on field trip days in order to be able to participate. We take ALL campers on our field trips and leave campus by 9 a.m. on field trip days and return to camp by lunchtime. Jefferson Parish School buses transport our group to and from field trip locations.
